

South Bend's Saint Augustine's Catholic Church Soup Kitchen is looking for volunteers. The soup kitchen is open each Monday, Wednesday and Friday (except holidays) from 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM.

Volunteers prepare items to go into brown grocery bags distributed to guests. Tasks include making peanut butter and jelly sandwiches, dipping canned fruit into styrofoam cups, bagging or boxing donated donuts and other baked goods, dipping previously-made soup into styrofoam cups, cleaning up after 12:30. Volunteer hours usually run from 9 AM until 1 PM. Shorter time periods could be worked out.

IN MEMORIAM

Jeanette A. "Jan" Mihelich June 20, 1921 - May 17, 2016



Jan, the oldest of three children, was born in Chicago, Illinois, to Wesley and Esther Van Osdol. She was raised in the Indianapolis, Indiana area. Upon graduation from Hanover College in Hanover, Indiana, she continued on to graduate school at the University of Illinois in Champaign-Urbana, pursuing an advanced degree in physics.

While studying at the University of Illinois, she met John Mihelich, also a physics graduate student. After a six-month courtship, they were married on December 22, 1946. Several years later, John and Jan moved to New York, where John completed his post-graduate work. During this time Jan stayed busy raising their three young children.

In 1954 the Mihelich Family moved to South Bend, Indiana, where John began his 30-year career as a Notre Dame physics professor. Jan, equipped with a teaching degree, was involved in education as a substitute teacher, as a teacher to home-bound students and in the IUSB Physics lab. She was also a lifelong volunteer in organizations as varied as AAUW, League of Women Voters, Memorial Hospital and the First Presbyterian Church of South Bend. In 1986-87 she served as president of the Ladies of Notre Dame and Saint Mary's College.

In 2012 Jan and John moved to Fort Collins, Colorado, to be nearer their daughters. In typical fashion Jan and John became deeply involved in activities at their Rigden Farm Senior Living Community and their new place of worship, Christ United Methodist Church.

Jan is survived by John, her husband of 69 years; their 3 children, John Jr. (Vicki), Kathryn (John Helms) and Peggy (Eric Bostwick); eight grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren

Following a two-week illness, Jan passed away in a Fort Collins Hospital on May 17, 2016. Services were held at Christ United Methodist Church in Fort Collins on May 21, 2016.

In Memoriam

Alice Flynn Osberger November 12, 1928 - June 30, 2016



The youngest of three children, Alice was born in Saint Joseph, Missouri, the daughter of Dorothy Byrne Flynn and Frank Flynn. After graduation from the Convent of the Sacred Heart High School, Alice enrolled at Saint Mary's College, Notre Dame, Indiana. In doing so, she followed in the footsteps of her grandmother, Julia Nunning Byrne, who graduated from Saint Mary's in 1877. While at Saint Mary's, Alice went on a blind date with a Notre Dame student named Daniel Osberger. That first meeting in November 1947, for a Notre Dame-Army Victory Dance, led to romance and, ultimately, marriage in the Lady Chapel of Sacred Heart Church, Notre Dame, on September 23, 1950.

While Dan spent 36 years working in Notre Dame administration, Alice stayed busy raising 4 children and staying very active in many community and educational organizations. She taught in several South Bend/ Mishawaka schools, then served many years as an administrative assistant in various Notre Dame departments. She received a Master's degree in teaching from Notre Dame in 1969. Alice preferred the working world to retirement, staying actively involved until shortly before her death. Her impressive list of volunteer activities varied from hosting international students to volunteering at the DeBartolo Performing Arts Center to publishing a book on Flynn Family genealogy to active membership in LND/SMC.

Alice was preceded in death by her beloved husband Dan. The couple celebrated their 46th wedding anniversary shortly before his August 1966 passing. She is survived by two older brothers, Robert and Frank; four children, Julie, Kathleen, Daniel (Mary Jean, an active member of our organization and its president in 1994-95) and Peggy (Joe); seven grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren, with a third due this summer.
